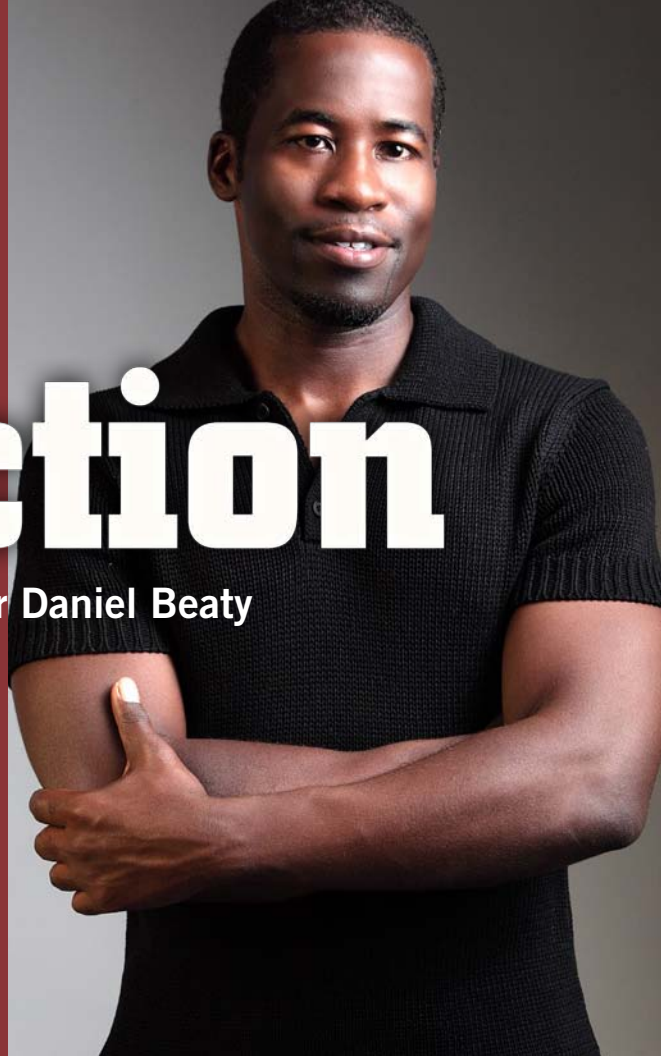

RESURRECTION is the latest solo work by Daniel Beaty, 2007 Obie Award Winner for Outstanding Writing and Performance for Emergence-See! *RESURRECTION* is the story of six interconnected black males ages 10 through 60—a child scientist, a young man from the projects on his way to college, an ex-convict, a corporate executive, a health food store owner, and a Bishop of a mega church—who all experience a phenomenon on the same evening that changes their lives forever. As they tell their stories they resurrect, individually and collectively, issues of physical, spiritual and mental health, poverty, absent fathers, incarceration, addiction, relationships, and education.

Featuring Daniel Beaty's unique blend of music, poetry, comedy, and drama, *RESURRECTION* is an urgent, timely story of possibility and hope.
