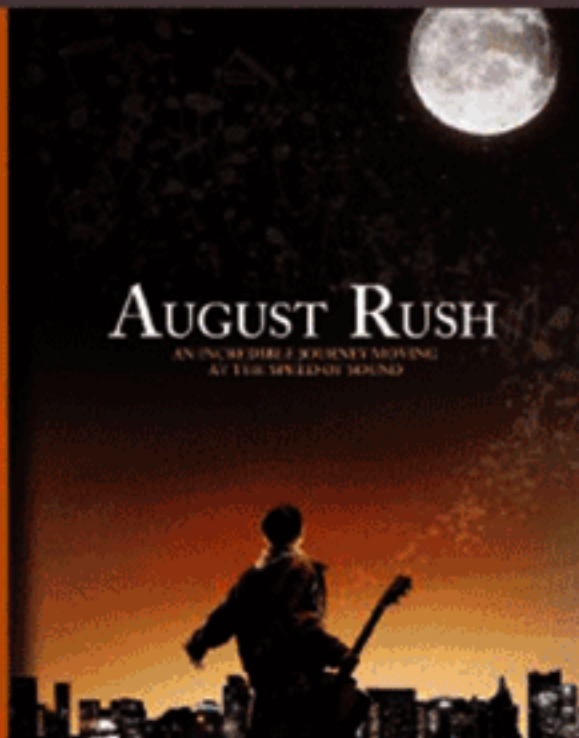

IMPACT programs provides a learning environment that encourages nurtures and challenges its students. Using the creative and performing arts and leadership training as a basis for teaching, the program empowers youth to effect positive change in their lives by focusing on life skills, college readiness, and cultural, social awareness.

In 10 years, IMPACT has worked with over 500 young people, ages 12 to 21 and staged more than 700 performances to live audiences totaling well over 150,000. IMPACT members have performed at schools, correctional facilities, community centers, homeless shelters, churches, outdoor festivals, universities, corporate events and renowned venues: the Public Theatre, the Schomburg, Lincoln Center and the Apollo Theatre.
